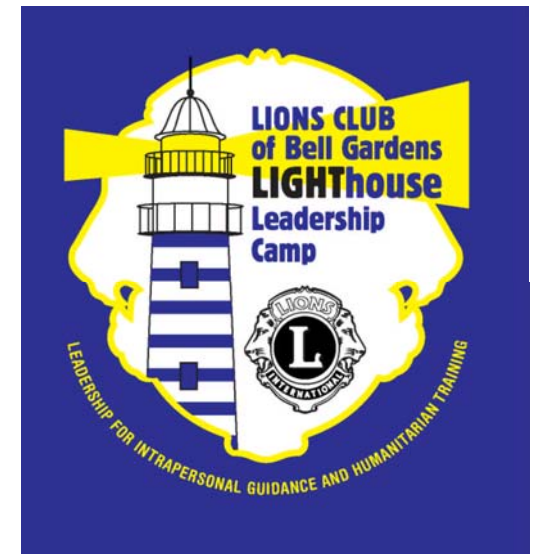

# WHAT IS LIGHTHOUSE?



LIGHThouse is a week long conference/camp designed for high school aged youth with a focus on leadership and humanitarian skills. Delegates of LIGHThouse attend group sessions with topics such as communications, group dynamics, intercultural awareness, and community support.

## HOW ARE SESSIONS TAUGHT?

All sessions are facilitated by highly trained staff in an interactive manner that encouraged involvement and a forum for open discussion. An activity that demonstrates the leadership skill often accompanies the sessions.

## WHERE IS LIGHTHOUSE HELD?

Currently, LIGHThouse is held in Lake Arrowhead at Arrowhead Ranch in the beautiful San Bernardino Mountains. Formally the 1984 Winter Olympic Village, Arrowhead Ranch holds up to 150 campers and hosts a dance hall, pool, basketball court, sand volleyball court and a fire pit/outdoor theater. Delegates sleep in dorms with up to 10 other delegates. Each dorm has its own restroom and shower. Mattresses are provided for each bunk. Arrowhead Ranch prepares 3 healthy meals a day and snacks are provided throughout the day.

## HOW DOES ONE ATTEND LIGHTHOUSE AS A DELEGATE?

Delegates are hand selected by the sponsoring LIONS Club. Delegates should meet the following requirements;

- 1. High School age.** Entering high school in the fall through just having graduated.
- 2. Community Involvement.** Volunteering in the community or volunteering with a local non-profit. Member of local Boys & Girls Club, Explorers programs, or High School Clubs.
- 3. LIONS Sponsorship.** Applications will become available in the spring. Applications are only available from the LIONS Club.

Delegates are not able to pay their own way to camp. Delegates **MUST** receive a scholarship to attend Lions LIGHThouse camp.

## HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

The cost per delegate is \$300. The LIONS club and community will provide scholarships to all selected delegates. **THERE IS NO COST TO THE DELEGATE.** Delegates may not pay their own way.
